Commonwealth Coordinated Care Plus (CCC Plus) Overview

The Commonwealth Coordinated Care Plus (CCC Plus) program is a mandatory managed care program that operates statewide and provides services to members with complex care needs. CCC Plus populations include members who are aged, blind, or disabled, including members who are dually eligible for Medicare and Medicaid and members who receive long-term services and supports (LTSS) through a home and community based care waiver or nursing facility.

For the purpose of assuring network adequacy at CCC Plus program go live and during the CCC Plus program implementation, the CCC Plus managed care organization (MCO) Contractors must submit their provider network to the Department electronically in a MS-Excel spreadsheet as part of the readiness review and ongoing CCC Program reporting requirements. The Contractor shall submit those providers with whom it has a signed contract. A complete list shall include all providers that are contracted directly with the Contractor and providers that are contracted through a subcontractor of the Contractor for the purpose of rendering services to CCC Plus members. Hereafter referred to as "Contractors network".

Network Submission Requirements Manual (NSRM)

The CCC Plus Network Submission Requirements Manual (NSRM) identifies DMAS' data submission requirements for network submission by contracted MCOs.

Network Submission General Information

1. Submission Format

The Contractor's network submission must be submitted electronically in a MS Excel format.

2. Submission Frequency

Network Files will be submitted monthly starting from March 2017. Files are due by the 20th of each month unless otherwise directed by DMAS. Post Network Files to SharePoint in the "Networks Adequacy" folder. Full CCC Plus line of business network submission is required for all monthly submissions. Final readiness network that will be used to determine network adequacy for each regions is the file submitted three months ahead of the go live date for a specific region. For example, May network file will be used to determine Tidewater region final network readiness and June network file will be used to determine Central regional final network readiness, etc.

For the May 2017 submission, submit the entire CCC Plus Network. The entire network will be reviewed for Statewide adequacy; however, network determination will be phased in.

3. Comprehensive Services Assessment

DMAS uses data from the Contractor's network submission to assess whether the Contractor has signed contracts with an appropriate range of primary care practitioners, clinical specialists, nursing facilities, and service facilities (hospitals, labs, behavioral health care providers, adult day care centers, waiver services providers, home health care providers, physicians, etc.) within the Contractor's service area. Only providers within the State of Virginia and its neighboring States (West Virginia, Tennessee, Kentucky, North Carolina, Maryland, and the District of Columbia (Washington, D.C.)) should be included on the network file. Exceptions: Providers in Designations 06 (LTSS), 17 (DME), 20 (Labs) and 21

(Pharmacy) may be included even if outside of Virginia and the neighboring States. Evaluations are completed on Contractors serving CCC Plus members.

4. Network Analysis

The Contractor's network submission is analyzed and evaluated by DMAS to determine network adequacy.

NSRM Data File Layout Specifications

The Contractor shall strictly follow all layout specifications from naming conventions for the file name and column header names, to actual data and value set within each data element. In addition, the Contractor shall ensure:

- The file name should be composed of the Contractor's abbreviated name + month and year of the submission + NS+xlsx. For example, February 2017 submission from United should be named as: UHC022017NS.xlsx. NOTE: ".xlsx" extension is included in the example to ensure that only Excel files are submitted. PDF, Word, Text or any other file type will not be accepted. Acceptable Contractor abbreviations are:
 - o AET Aetna
 - ANT Anthem
 - o MCC Magellan
 - o OPT Optima
 - \circ UHC United
 - VAP Virginia Premier
- Format the Excel spreadsheet using the EXACT Data Element Names as column headings. Follow the Data Specifications provided as mentioned in the detailed section of each Field Name. Do not abbreviate and do not add any other characters. NOTE: Files will fail if the column headings are not labeled correctly.
- The entire network shall be in one file, formatted as shown below.
- Do NOT submit separate files or separate worksheets within one file.
- If a provider has more than one physical office location, each location should be submitted; however, list each provider location separately.
- If a provider has more than one provider designation, each designation should be submitted; however, list each designation separately. (See example on page 13).
- If a provider has more than one taxonomy in one location, each taxonomy should be submitted; however, list each provider taxonomy separately.
- Please ensure the primary taxonomy is labeled properly. If a provider only has one taxonomy, this record should be labeled as the primary taxonomy.
- List each separate location on a separate row in the spreadsheet.
- Fields labeled as a "Required Field" must be included for every record in the file.

5. Critical and Key Provider Designations

Critical Provider Designations – used by DMAS management to make Go/No Go decisions and includes:

- 01 Primary Care Provider (PCP)
- 02 Pediatrician
- 25 OB/GYN
- 07 Outpatient Mental Health
- 21 Pharmacy
- 11 General Hospital

Key Provider Designations – Health Plan will need to submit exception requests, if network adequacy standards are not going to be met:

- 01 Primary Care Provider (PCP)
- 02 Pediatrician
- 25 OB/GYN
- 07 Outpatient Mental Health
- 21 Pharmacy
- 11 General Hospital
- 14 Nursing Facility (Skilled and Intermediate)
- 03 Specialist
- 06 Long Term Services & Supports (LTSS), Adult Day Health Center (S5102)

NOTE: As the program matures, the above Critical and Key Provider Designations are subject to change.

Submissions not meeting these requirements will be rejected and returned. To be evaluated, a corrected file must be returned within ten (10) calendar days; otherwise, the network requirements will be rated unsatisfactory.

7. Data Element Definitions with Examples

Health Plan Name

Data Element Name: HEALTHPLAN Format: Character **Required for:** Identification **Length:** 50

Definition:

Please use the official health plan name acronym for this field.

Edit Applications:

1. This is a required data element. An entry for health plan name must be on the record in order for the record to be accepted.

2. Records from the same health plans should contain the same health plan name acronym under this field.

Example:

1. Anthem

Please use the API number assigned by DMAS for your CCC Plus line of business once it is available. Health plan should leave this field blank until the API is assigned by DMAS.

Edit Applications:

1. This is an optional data element

2. Records from the same health plans should contain the same health plan API number under this field

Example:

The National Provider Identifier (NPI) is a unique identification number for covered health care providers. The Federal Government mandated the use of only NPI for electronic healthcare transactions. The NPI number is issued under the direction of the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS). All providers must report the NPI of all their participating providers for the quarterly or annual Provider Network Data submission. For additional information on NPI, visit www.cms.hhs.gov/NationalProvIdentStand/. NPI is required; API nor a default value will be accepted. If the provider does not have an NPI, leave this field blank while an NPI is being obtained. Please be advised, that providers without an NPI will not be included in the analysis.

The current network analysis will not validate the NPI number(s) submitted. However, at some point in the future, DMAS will use the National Plan and Provider Enumeration System (NPPES) to validate that the NPI number submitted is on the national database and is still effective.

Edit Applications:

1. Must be a valid National Provider Identifier (NPI) number. The NPI is a 10-position numeric identifier (10-digit number).

2. This is a required data element. An entry must be made for every participating provider record in order for the record to be accepted. Leave blank, if an NPI is not yet available.

3. The NPI is validated for each record on the entire submission. If you're NPI error percentage is higher than the allowable threshold of 10%, your entire submission will be rejected.

4. No provider is exempt from the NPI requirement for CCC Plus. This includes transportation providers. The recommended process for providers to obtain and NPI is as follows: See paragraph D of the NPI application (<u>https://www.cms.gov/Medicare/CMS-Forms/CMS-Forms/CMS-Forms/downloads/CMS10114.pdf</u>); follow the link in paragraph D to the "Health Care Provider Taxonomy" (<u>http://www.wpc-edi.com/reference/codelists/healthcare/health-care-provider-taxonomy-code-set/</u>); find the category that fits the service provided in order for NPPES to issue the NPI. Examples: Non-emergency Medical Transport (VAN) - **34390000X**, Private Vehicle - **347C0000X**, Secured Medical Transport (VAN) - **343800000X**, Taxi - **344600000X**, Transportation Broker - **347E00000X**.

Example:

1. Dr. Yucha participates in Medicaid & Medicare and his NPI is 1789654320. Enter "1789654320" in this field.

2. Dr. Phil participates in Commercial & Child Health Plus and her NPI is 1334445555. Enter "1334445555" in this field.

3. Dr. Kelleher participates in Medicaid, HIV SNP and Commercial & Child Health Plus but has not yet received an NPI. Leave this field blank until the NPI is assigned.

The last name of an individual provider, the practice name, or the facility name of the provider contracted with the health plan to provide services to enrollees.

Edit Applications:

1. Last name is a required data element. An entry for last name must be on the record in order for the record to be accepted.

2. Must be left justified.

Example:

2. The last name "Smith" occupies five character positions.

The first name of an individual provider contracted with the health plan to provide services to enrollees.

Edit Applications:

1. The first name is a required data element. However, leave blank if a facility or practice name is listed above. An entry for first name must be on the record unless a facility or practice name is listed in order for the record to be accepted.

2. If in the rare instance a provider does not have a first name, 'NONAME' should be entered in the first name data field.

3. Must be left justified.

Example:

The first name "David" occupies five character positions.

Data Element Name: GROUPAFFIL Format: Character

Definition:

The Group Affiliation identifies the medical or provider group that the provider is affiliated with.

Edit Applications:

1. Not a required element

Example:

1. Dr. Valentine is affiliated with VCU health system hospital or Dr. Valentine is affiliated with Richmond Primary Care. His affiliation would be entered for this data element.

Hospital Affiliation

Data Element Name: HOSPITALAFFIL Format: Character **Required for:** Practice Length: 1

Definition:

The Hospital Affiliation identifies if the medical or provider group is affiliated with a hospital.

Edit Applications:

1. Valid Value is '1'-Yes or '0'-No.

Data Element Name: TAXONOMYCODE Format: Alphanumeric Required for: Practice Length: 10

Definition:

Unique ten character alphanumeric code that enables providers to identify their specialty at the claim level. Current taxonomy code values are listed on the DMAS Taxonomy Code Set list. See **Exhibit 1.**

For provider with more than one taxonomy included in the signed contract between a CCC Plus Health Plan and that provider, multiple records (rows) should be submitted with one for each taxonomy.

Edit Applications:

1. Taxonomy code is a required field.

Definition:

This data element determines if the taxonomy is primary or not. DMAS will continue counting providers with primary taxonomies for CCC Plus network adequacy analysis. In parallel, DMAS will evaluate and research a better way to consider network adequacy based on all multiple taxonomies under a single provider.

Edit Applications:

1. Valid Value '1'-Yes or '0'-No

Example:

- 1. Dr. Smith is a primary care doctor working with members of all ages. His primary designation would be "01".
- 2. Dr. Phillips is a pediatrician and his patients are all children. He should be coded as a primary designation as "02".
- 3. Examples of Specialists are listed in **Exhibit 2**. They (and any others not listed) should be coded as a primary designation as "03".

- 4. Fairfax County Health Department is a health department; therefore, the primary designation would be "04".
- 5. Heartland Hospice is a hospice facility; therefore, the primary designation would be a "05".
- 6. Jane Johnson is a LPN that provides PERS Nursing services and bills code H2021-TE. Her primary designation would be "06".
- 7. Dr. Foster is a mental health psychologist. Her primary designation would be "07".
- 8. XYZ Facility provides substance use partial hospitalization services. The facility's primary designation would be "08".
- 9. Keith Woods provides Community based Crisis Intervention and bills H0036 for his services. His primary designation would be "09".
- 10. Poplar Springs is a Psychiatric Hospital. Its primary designation would be "10".
- 11. St. Mary's is a general hospital. Its primary designation would be "11".
- 12. HealthSouth is a physical rehabilitation hospital. Its primary designation would be "12".
- 13. BetterMed Urgent Care is an urgent care provider; therefore, its designation would be "13".
- 14. LakeWood Manor is a skilled nursing facility. Its primary designation would be "14".
- 15. The Hermitage at Cedarfield is an intermediate care nursing facility. Its primary designation would be "14".
- 16. Alliance Physical Therapy is an outpatient rehabilitation facility. Its primary designation would be "16".
- 17. Advanced Home Medical provides durable medical equipment. Its primary designation would be "17".
- 18. Radiology Associates of Richmond provides radiology services. Its primary designation would be "18".
- 19. Bon Secours Home Care provides home health services. Its primary designation would be "19".
- 20. LabCorp provides lab services. Its primary designation would be "20".
- 21. CVS provides pharmaceuticals to individuals. Its primary designation would be "21".
- 22. Dr. Carey is an ophthalmologist. His primary designation would be "22".
- 23. Newby's Cab Service is a transportation provider. Its primary designation would be "23".
- 24. Any other providers not reflected above or below may be listed here, including providers of Enhanced Services. Please provide primary designation of "24".
- 25. Dr. Jefferson is an Obstetrician. Her primary designation would be "25".
- 26. Bland County Medical Clinic is an FQHC. Their primary designation would be "26".
- 27. District 19 is an CSB. Their primary designation would be "27".
- 28. Eastern Shore Rural Health is an RHC. Their primary designation would be "28".

Explanation:

If the provider listed provides mental health (provider designation 07) and substance use disorder community based (provider designation 08) services, repeat provider information on a separate row; however, the provider designation code will be different, and procedure code is required for provider designation 08. See example below.

Data Element Name: SUBCLASS
Format: Character

Definition:

If the provider is a Long Term Care Waiver Service Provider, please refer to valid value list in **Exhibit 3**. If the provider is a Substance Use Disorder (ARTS) Provider, please refer to valid value list in **Exhibit 4**. If the provider is a Community Based Mental Health Service Provider, please refer to valid value list in **Exhibit 5**.

Edit Applications:

1. Codes must be valid value from the procedure code list.

Do not leave blank for provider designations 06, 08, and 09. This is a required data element for all 06, 08, and 09 providers. For all other provider designations, this section can be left blank or filled with NA.
 Valid codes are in following table: See Exhibit 3, Exhibit 4 and Exhibit 5.

Preliminary networks submitted by Offerors with the RFP are not required to include the procedure codes. Procedure codes for provider designations 06, 08, and 09 shall be required with final network submissions during readiness and as part of the Contractor's on-going network submission.

Modifiers:

For any Sub-Class code that include a modifier, format the code and modifier with no spaces or symbols. See examples below:

- <u>H0035HB</u>
- <u>H0035HA</u>
- H0035HAUG
- H0035HAU7

Explanation:

If the provider listed provides LTC Waiver Service Code "S5102", then the valid value for this field is "S5102". If the provider listed provides Community Mental Health Rehabilitation service code 'H', then the valid value is "T1019". If there is more than one procedure code for same provider, repeat the information on a separate row; however, the procedure code will be different. See example below.

The street number and street name associated with the individual provider's location. *If the provider has more than one location, each location should be listed separately.*

Edit Applications:

- 1. This is a required data element.
- 2. Should never include room or suite number.
- 3. Must be left justified.
- 4. PO Box is not an acceptable or valid street address.

Example:

1. Dr. Mosby is located at 5972 Western Blvd would be entered as "5972 Western Boulevard".

2. Dr. Saunders is located at 329 West Seventh Street would be entered as "329 West 7th Street".

3. Dr. Little is located at 1646 Third Street would be entered as "1646 3rd Street".

The room or suite number associated with the individual provider's address. Most often the room or suite number coincides with the providers who are located in an office or professional building. List each location separately.

Edit Applications:

1. Room or suite number is not a required data element; however, please include if applicable.

2. Room or suite number information should never go in the street address field. If the room or suite number does not fit in the appropriate record positions, additional information can be added to the site name field.

3. If Not Applicable enter "NA".

Example:

1. Dr. Luke Smith is located in Suite 610 of the St. Luke's Professional Building. The entry for this data element would be "Suite 610" or "Room 610" (other location information could be entered: e.g., floor, wing, etc.).

The name of the town or city associated with the service location of the provider. There should be one record for each provider location.

Edit Applications:

1. This is a required data element.

2. Must be left justified.

Example:

1. Dr. Smith's office is located in Richmond, VA. Dr. Smith's city should be entered as "Richmond".

The federal government has identified a code for each State and county in the United States. The Federal Information Processing Standards (FIPS) code is a five-digit code for each State and county. DMAS will use all five-digits of the FIPS code to distinguish the State and counties for the provider.

Edit Application:

1. Must be a valid State and FIPS county code. This is a required data element.

3. Check to assure that zip code is included in the FIPS Code submitted.

Example:

1. Dr. Roofer's office is located in Henrico County and the office zip code is 23229. The State code for Virginia is "51". The county FIPS code for Henrico County is "087". 51087 is the code/number that should be entered in the FIPS Code field.

The name of the state in which the service provider is located; and it is a 2-character state abbreviation for each unique service location(s). These providers must be under contract to serve Virginia State residents.

Edit Applications:

1. Should be a valid U.S. Postal Service state code.

"DC" – District of Columbia "KY" – Kentucky "MD" – Maryland "NC" – North Carolina "TN" – Tennessee "VA" - Virginia "WV" – West Virginia

2. Do not leave blank. This is a required data element for all providers for all records.

Example:

1. Dr. Smith has one office in Virginia and another office across the Virginia state line in North Carolina. There should be one record with the state of "VA" and another separate record for Dr. Smith that has his North Carolina address and the state as "NC".

5-digit zip code for each unique service location(s); the zip code associated with the provider service address. The zip code is assigned by the United States Postal Service for the location of the provider's service location. There should be one record for each provider location.
