




- Coordination of Care






- **Rolling Enrollment**



5 Care Coordination


- Limited availability without CCC
- No additional cost
- Help with arranging your appointments and services
- Care Manager will get to know you and help you develop your care plan

What about my Doctors?

- Check if your doctor and other healthcare providers participate with one of the plans
- Transition period up to 6 months
- Your provider may contact your health plan to find out about joining the network

Important Dates

- **Voluntary enrollment**
 - Choose your plan during the voluntary enrollment phase
 - Your coverage with CCC starts the first of the next month
- **Automatic enrollment**
 - If you do not voluntarily sign up during voluntary enrollment, a plan will be chosen for you
- Remember **#2**! You can change plans or return to regular Medicare and Medicaid at any time
