Information Management Division seeks a working manager who can manage, coordinate and perform the user acceptance testing of changes made to the Medicaid Management information system on a regular basis. This position will also be responsible for quality of data and transfer of data from/to MMIS. In addition, there are Virginia Information Technologies Agency (VITA) project management standards, agency standards that require thorough testing of the software before it is approved for production. Candidates must have considerable knowledge and experience with Medicaid systems design, development, conversion, and testing with a working knowledge of computer programming. Requires extensive knowledge of systems testing, data analysis and design concepts and methodologies. Must have knowledge of emerging development tools and integration architecture and use of these tools in a distributed environment, including SOA, HL7, web technologies, and integration and data warehouse/ reporting products such as Filenet, HATS, and COGNOS. Requires ability to test for complex solutions while meeting user and Agency needs. Requires a demonstrated track record of leadership, planning, staff management, and project management, as well as experience managing direct and indirect staff and workgroups. Candidates must demonstrate strong communication skills to include the ability to lead and facilitate meetings, develop reports and communicate effectively with all levels of an organization. Graduation from an accredited college/university; advanced degree in information technology, computer science or business preferred; PMP preferred.
