Exciting opportunity to implement data warehouse for Department of Medical Assistance Services. The incumbent will serve as a technical expert for integrating disparate data sources and designing data model and data marts. The responsibilities include developing ETL code, scheduling jobs, implementing transformational rules, maintaining optimal performance of the warehouse, performance monitoring, capacity planning, developing test scripts, testing and identifying and resolving production issues, evaluating, and installing new releases for ETL tools. Incumbent must have extensive experience in implementing, evaluating and researching extraction, transformation, and cleaning of data and participate in user education and training. The qualified applicant must have comprehensive knowledge of healthcare, preferably Medicaid and Medicare. Experience with data warehouse design, and strong understanding of data structure and data organization concepts is a must. Requires experience with EDW, ODS, DM, ROLAP, and MOLAP. Must have experience with change data capture, data integration, and other data extraction, matching, and merging processes. Requires experience working with ETL tools such as Informatica, Ab initio, Datastage, SSIS or Oracle Data Integrator (ODI); working knowledge of SQL, SAS, R, or STATA. Must have comprehensive knowledge of how to consume services and produce data. Familiarity with software life cycle methodology a plus. Requires proven ability to communicate effectively orally and in writing including translating complex statistical reports and concepts to all levels of audiences. Bachelor's degree preferred in Information Systems or Computer Science or equivalent degree.
