Seeking experienced provider contracting or network manager to develop innovative approaches to assessing the health care provider networks of health plans serving the Virginia Medicaid managed care program. This new position within the Division of Health Care Services is responsible for ensuring that managed care facility and provider networks are comprehensive, geographically accessible, and of high quality. The incumbent will be instrumental in promoting enhanced approaches to assessing health plan compliance with provider network requirements for existing Medicaid populations and Virginia Medicaid reform initiatives, and be responsible for managing pilot projects focused on innovative financial arrangements linked to quality improvements. Applicants must have a strong foundation in provider contracting, network development, provider reimbursement, and managed care contracting within hospitals or health systems/provider groups, commercial or Medicaid health plans. Must have experience serving as lead or a member of work groups and collaborative efforts requiring health care delivery system expertise. Requires demonstrated ability to communicate with leadership, providers and other stakeholders effectively through oral presentations as well as written reports. Must have experience in the analyzing and developing of health care and managed care policy, legislation, regulations with particular focus on the implications for the development of health care provider delivery systems. Must be proficient using spreadsheet, presentation and word processing application software for analytical reports and presentations. Graduate of accredited college or university with major course work in business/public administration, healthcare administration, nursing or other related health care field; Master's degree is strongly preferred. Education, training, and experience are interchangeable.
