Unique opportunity for IT professional to work as an Oracle application developer for the Information Management Division. This position requires design, development and maintenance of Oracle Application Express (APEX), PL/SQL, and Oracle Forms/Reports and other web technologies and e-Business Suite applications. Applicants must be proficient in PL/SQL, relational database systems - specifically Oracle, HTML, CSS and JavaScript. Experience in MMIS systems, and database administration tasks are a plus. Must have hands-on experience in the design, development and maintenance of APEX applications. Requires working knowledge of software development life cycle, configuration management and performance tuning. Considerable knowledge of relational database concepts, data modeling and Oracle RDBMS architecture is preferred. Proven strong analytical, problem solving skills and knowledge of enterprise architectural patterns are preferred. Must be able to plan and complete assigned work on time, manage multiple projects with dynamic priorities, and ability to work in a fast paced environment with occasional non-business hours (evenings and weekends) flexibility. Demonstrated experience understanding and interpreting customer requirements and developing solutions to meet requirements. Proven ability to develop and maintain system documentation, including technical specifications, data mapping, program logic and flowcharts.
