The Division of Information Management seeks a highly motivated, strong team player for an exciting, key role opportunity as the Department of Medical Assistance (DMAS) moves towards a modernized Medicaid Enterprise Systems (MES) environment. This position will drive continuous improvement by establishing high expectations for superior work quality, executing creative problem solving, and building a positive and collaborative team environment. The successful applicant will serve in a business-to-system liaison capacity working with COTS packages and will conduct COTS system capability analysis comparable to DMAS business needs, prepare GAP analysis, and provide guidance to the business users for best fit or alternate solutions. Must have overall Medicaid business and system knowledge, and Systems Development Life Cycle experience. Knowledge of the Medicaid Information Technology Architecture (MITA 3.0), telecommunications with loosely coupled multi-platform systems, Enterprise Service Bus and Service-Oriented Architecture is desirable. Experience with other large scale healthcare claims processing, health benefit structures, managed care, implementations, and/or support of Commercial off the Shelf (COTS) software solutions or Software as a Service (SaaS) solutions is a plus. As the Information Management technical coordinator of multiple complex Information Technology (IT) applications, candidates must have demonstrated ability to plan and complete work assignments. Requires proven communication skills with the ability to communicate clearly and effectively orally and in writing. Must be able to quickly adapt to new technical environments (multiple disciplines) and manage multiple projects with dynamic priorities. Experience working with vendors is a plus. Working knowledge of emerging technology, tools, and standards, including SOA, HL7, web technologies, and integration and data warehouse/reporting products a plus. Bachelor's Degree in information systems, computer science, or business required; several years' direct equivalent experience can substitute.
