The Virginia Department of Medical Assistance Services (DMAS) invites you to attend a meeting on June 2, 2015, from 1:30-2:30 that pertains to proposed initiative for transitioning Medicaid populations who are currently served through the DMAS fee-for-service delivery model into an integrated managed care program. The anticipated implementation timeframe for this Managed Long-term Services and Supports (MLTSS) initiative is mid-2017.
