

Overview

- Since 1996, the state has been committed to Medicaid managed care
- The state's focus has been three fold
 - 1- patient care and services
 - 2- provider engagement
 - 3- positive outcomes

Statewide Partners

- Medallion II is statewide as of July 2012:
 - from the sea to the mountains to the plains
- To provide coverage for 700,000 enrollees, we have successfully partnered with
 - 13 health systems
 - 12,000 PCPs
 - 7 health plans



Quality

- Medallion II program has a strong quality component
- All health plans are NCQA accredited
- Plans work with the Department on 2 projects and have specific quality goals and evaluation

It Gets Better

- Medallion II is being transformed
- The new July 1st contract incorporates:
 - New reporting and analytical capacities
 - Chronic care management
 - Focus on maternity
 - Program integrity enhancements
 - Partnership system - the plans are encouraged to have two innovation models {from medicals home to incentive models}
 - Quality incentive programs - the plans will look at 6 measures {3 clinical and 3 processing} and be rewarded for their success

Managed Care Initiatives

- Medicaid managed care is working on 4 new initiatives:
 - Foster care and adoption assistance – live in NOVA December 1
 - Expedited enrollment – shortening the pre-assignment period – July 1
 - Health and acute care project – covering acute care services for waiver populations – Fall 2014
 - Collaboratives – Quality, PI and ER diversion - Ongoing

DMAS Initiatives

- DMAS is working on 4 major initiatives as part of the MIRC:
 - Dual-eligible demonstration – Medicaid and Medicare project schedule to go live in Winter 2014
 - BHSA – for FFS behavioral health and community mental health – December 1
 - MAGI – new enrollment system and eligibility rules – October 1
 - Cover Virginia – the new call center – October 1

The Changing Landscape of Managed Care in Northern Virginia: History

- December 1, 2001
 - UniCare & MEDALLION
- September 1, 2005
 - Amerigroup
- 2006
 - Anthem & WellPoint Merge: UniCare becomes Anthem HealthKeepers Plus

The Changing Landscape of Managed Care in Northern Virginia

- WellPoint acquires Amerigroup in December 2012 (outside of Virginia)
- Inova acquires Amerigroup's Virginia business to become INTotal Health on July 1, 2013
- NOW: INTotal & Anthem HealthKeepers Plus
- Kaiser Permanente effective November 1, 2013
