BabyCare

Provider Fact Sheet

Purpose	The goal of the BabyCare Program is to improve pregnancy and birth outcomes.
Services Offered	<p>The BabyCare program includes two components:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Case management for high risk pregnant women and infants up to age two by a Registered Nurse or Social Worker. • Expanded prenatal services for pregnant women including patient education classes (including tobacco cessation), nutritional services, homemaker services and substance abuse treatment services (SATS) by an approved provider. • Provider requirements are detailed in Chapter II of the BabyCare provider manual located at http://websrvr.dmas.virginia.gov/ProviderManuals/Default.aspx
Who is Eligible?	<p>Case management services are available for high risk pregnant women and infants up to age two who are enrolled in the Fee For Service (FFS), FAMIS Plus, FAMIS, or FAMIS MOMS benefit.</p> <p>Expanded prenatal services are available to any pregnant woman who is enrolled in the FFS, FAMIS Plus, FAMIS, or FAMIS MOMS benefit.</p> <p>DMAS Managed Care Organizations (MCOs) have their own high risk maternity programs except for SATS which is covered only through the Department of Medical Assistance Services (DMAS).</p>
Service Requirements and Limitations for FFS enrollees	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pregnant women are eligible for BabyCare during pregnancy and up to the end of the month following their 60th day post-partum. • Infants are eligible for case management up to their second birthday. • DMAS must prior authorize case management services for fee-for-service enrollees.

<p>Screening</p>	<p>DMAS reimburses for administration and interpretation of the <i>Behavioral Health Risks Screening Tool for Women of Child Bearing Age</i> (DMAS 16). This screening tool replaces the Maternity Risk Screen (DMAS 16) and the Infant Risk Screen (DMAS 17). The purpose for the screening is to identify and assist pregnant women as well as new mothers who may be at risk for mental health, substance use or intimate partner violence as well as infants who may be at risk for developmental issues secondary to their family situation and mother's risks.</p>		
<p>Preauthorization Process</p>	<p>The BabyCare Case Manager must complete a face-to-face assessment of the client, as well as complete the Letter of Agreement (or equivalent) and Service Plan. The documentation must be kept in the client's medical record. To request preauthorization of case management, the BabyCare provider needs to send only the Maternal or Infant BabyCare Case Management Preauthorization Request Form (DMAS 50 M or I) to DMAS at the contact below.</p>
