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VIRGINIA MEDICAID MANAGED CARE

- 1. Began in 1996 mandatory enrollment is statewide.
- 2. Medallion 3.0 formally known as Medallion II
- 3. Covers 771, 398 members: children, aged, blind, disabled, care taker parents, pregnant women, and acute care for waiver recipients
- 4. Partners with 6 health plans Anthem, Aetna Better Health, INTotal (Inova), Kaiser Permanente, Optima (Sentara), and Virginia Premier (VCU)
- 5. All plans are NCQA accredited; Annual HEDIS data is used to evaluate the plans and to work on quality initiatives
- 6. Annual contracting and rate development cycle
- 7. Plans provide budgetary predictability and more administrative benefits than in FFS such as: call center, 24/7 access, enhanced provider networks, staff, care management and technology
- 8. Plans provide vital encounter data (used for RX rebate, reporting) and collaborate on Program Integrity and Quality initiatives to ensure accountability and compliance
- 9. New projects include partnerships, quality and value-based incentives
