Nicotine Replacement Therapy and Non-nicotine Medication for all Fee-for-Service Members	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Coverage for all Fee-For-Service members, not just pregnant members • All drugs on Preferred Drug List (PDL) require prescription for payment (including over-the-counter). Service authorization is required for drugs not on the PDL. • Dispense no greater than 34 day supply at a time. • Refills may be dispensed in sufficient quantity to fulfill the prescription order. <p><i>NOTE: Prescribing physicians should indicate "PREGNANCY" on the prescription form for prescriptions (including OTCs) related to the women's pregnancies.</i></p> <p>Visit dmasva.dmas.virginia.gov for the current list of covered drugs, under Pharmacy Services.</p>	
Transportation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To/from appts (pregnant women only) and pharmacy (all Fee-For-Service members) • Logisticare Reservations: 1-866-386-8331 / MCO members: Contact MCO directly. 	
Copayments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No copayments for pregnancy related services or members under age 21 • Non-pregnant members, over age 21 and enrolled in Fee-For-Service Medicaid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ \$1 co-pay for generic smoking cessation medications ○ \$3 co-pay for brand name smoking cessation medications

Documentation Requirements for Counseling for Pregnant Women	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Result of medical evaluation (may be consultation with prenatal care provider) • History • Diagnosis of tobacco use • Plan of care • Progress notes • Discharge plan and summary 	
Managed Care Organizations (MCO)	<p>In order to be reimbursed for tobacco cessation services provided to Managed Care Organization (MCO) enrolled individuals, providers must follow their respective contract with the MCO. The MCO may utilize different prior authorization, billing, and reimbursement guidelines than those described for Medicaid/FAMIS fee-for-service individuals.
