

Opioid Use Disorder Preferred/Formulary Drugs for Fee-for-Service, Medallion 4.0 and Commonwealth Coordinated Care (CCC) Plus Health Plans

Last Updated July 1, 2021

The following drugs **do not require a prior authorization (PA)** when prescribed by a buprenorphine waived practitioner (BWP) in-network or credentialed with a managed care health plan:

- naltrexone (oral)
- Suboxone® film \leq 24mg/day **per Board of Medicine guidance**
- Sublocade™
- Vivitrol® (naltrexone injection)

Buprenorphine monoprodukt \leq 24mg/day **per Board of Medicine guidance** for pregnant patients (determined by pregnancy diagnosis, prenatal vitamins, or diagnosis indicated on PA). Preferred Office-Based Opioid Treatment (OBOT) providers may prescribe without restrictions.

The opioid antagonists below may be written by any in-network or credentialed prescriber:

- naloxone syringe & vial
- naltrexone tab
- Narcan® Nasal Spray
- Vivitrol®

The following drugs **require a PA** when prescribed by a buprenorphine waived practitioner (BWP) in-network or credentialed with a managed care health plan:

- buprenorphine/naloxone tab SL
- buprenorphine/naloxone film SL
- Cassipa®
- Probuphine®
- Zubsolv
- Evzio® injection

All Buprenorphine Containing Drugs (non-preferred) and Evzio® require submission of a service authorization.
