# Brain Injury Services Targeted Case Management



## **Information Sheet for Providers**

What is Brain Injury Services Targeted Case Management (BIS TCM)?	BIS TCM are state plan case management services for Medicaid eligible individuals living in the community, age 18 years or older, who have a physician-documented diagnosis of traumatic brain injury (TBI); and who have severe functional limitations due to their TBI as indicated by the Mayo Portland Adaptability Inventory (MPAI-4) assessment. Individuals residing in an inpatient facility may qualify for BIS TCM if being discharged to community within 6 months.
What are the case manager's responsibilities as part of the BIS TCM?	<ul> <li>Obtain client history.</li> <li>Develop individualized service plan (ISP).</li> <li>Assist in developing, locating, obtaining, or scheduling of needed medical and support services.</li> <li>Periodically monitor the care that the individual is receiving.</li> <li>Revise and update the ISP as needed.</li> <li>Complete and update in ISP a minimum of one BIS TCM activity each month and at least one face-to-face contact with the individual at least every 90 calendar days.</li> </ul>
What are the required provider/agency qualifications and requirements for becoming a BIS TCM provider?	<ul> <li>Be accredited by Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF).</li> <li>Guarantee individuals' access to 24-hour emergency services.</li> <li>Demonstrate ability to serve individuals in need of comprehensive services regardless of the individual's ability to pay or eligibility for reimbursement.</li> <li>Have administrative and financial management capacity to meet state and federal requirements.</li> <li>Have ability to document and maintain individual case records in accordance with state and federal requirements.</li> </ul>
What are the required case manager qualifications for providing the BIS TCM?	<ul> <li>Have a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university, or be a registered nurse (RN).</li> <li>Be a Qualified Brian Injury Support Provider (QBISP) or Certified Brian Injury Specialist (CBIS).</li> </ul>
What are the billing codes and reimbursement rates for BIS TCM?	Billing Codes: The following codes are billed as a monthly unit as authorized by the MCO or FFS vendors:  • S0280 = Assessment for BIS TCM services  • S0281 = BIS TCM services Reimbursement rate for one unit of each of S0280 and S0281 is \$380.56
