

# Virginia Medicaid ID Cards

## Valid for Use after January 1, 2023

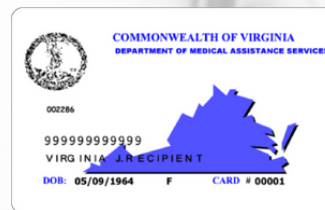
Virginia Medicaid launched Cardinal Care - its new name for all its health coverage programs - on January 1, 2023. The new name means that some members will receive new identification (ID) cards, while some members will not.

Here are the details:

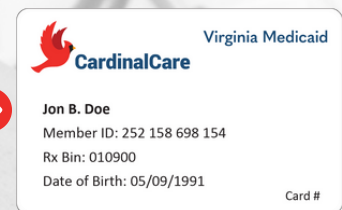
### Managed Care Members

All Virginia Medicaid Members who participate in a managed care health plan will receive a new ID card from their health plan by mid-2023. These cards will include the health plan logo and the Cardinal Care logo.

### New Cardinal Care ID Card

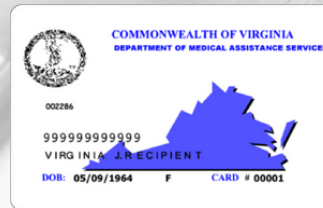

### Fee-for-Service, FAMIS and Plan First Medicaid Members

If you were a fee-for-service, FAMIS, or Plan First Medicaid member before January 1, 2023, you will not receive a new card and will continue to use your Medicaid cards (shown right).

### Current Medicaid ID Card

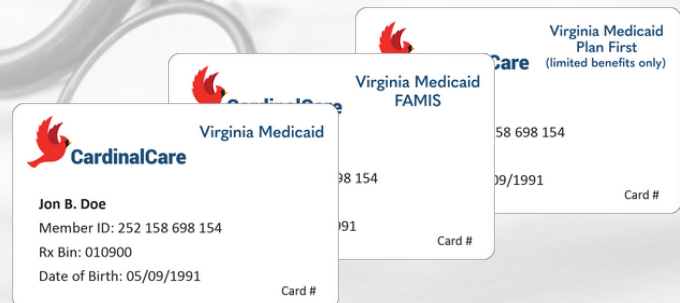


### Current PlanFirst ID Card



If you became a fee-for-service, FAMIS or Plan First members after January 1, 2023, you will receive a Cardinal Care fee-for-service, Cardinal Care FAMIS or Cardinal Care Plan First card (shown right)

### New Cardinal Care ID cards



The old blue-and-white cards, the green-and-white cards, and the new Cardinal Care cards are valid for use and for all claims processing.
